HCR September 2022 Members' Survey: Overview



- OBJECTIVE: Obtain critical feedback from HCR's Members so we can:
 - Construct a 2023 Event Calendar to better reflect their interests in our EVENTS.
 - Explore how we can COMMUNICATE most effectively with our Members.
 - Better understand how HCR's Leadership Team is PERFORMING.
 - Capture their interests in VOLUNTEERING in HCR's events and/or activities.
- MECHANISM: A Google Forms Mini-Survey was created, consisting of Five questions:
- **RESULTS:**
 - Member Feedback was EXTREMELY POSITIVE & INFORMATIVE
 - 228 participants vs. 98 in 2021

HCR September 2022 Members' Survey: Key Observations



EVENTS

- In general, ranking of our Driving and Social events remained the same Year-Year
- Overall interest in most events decreased Year-Year
- Participants expressed strong interest in several events not currently offered

COMMUNICATIONS

- Most participants prefer receiving HCR info via our current communication mechanisms
- In addition to the existing mechanisms, preference for communications between members, and between members and HCR suggests adding an online forum/chatroom.

VOLUNTEERING


- > 37% of Survey respondents either are volunteers, or are interested in volunteering
 - 56 members expressed interest in volunteering!

- Participants who had questions or expressed concerns are being contacted


HCR Members' DRIVING Activity Interests

228/98 respondents (2022/2021)



Q3: What is your preferred method of receiving communications from HCR?




- Most HCR Members are satisfied with our current communications mechanisms.

Q1: Which HCR EVENTS would you be interested participating in?




- Participants' event interests are shown on the following slides
 - Overall interest for many events decreased Year-Year.
 - Could be due to 2021 member enthusiasm in attending events as the COVID-19 pandemic was receding, followed by 2022 socialization return to (almost) normal causing drop in event interest this year.
 - Driving
 - Strong interest in starting an Adult Car Control Clinic
 - Also in Overnight/Weekend Tours
 - Social
 - Informal Get-together (new event 2022) is extremely popular!
 - Lunch Bunch members' interest wasn't polled due to an inadvertent survey omission.
 - However, it continues to be a very popular event, including HCR currently nurturing a new South Austin Lunch Bunch activity.
 - Consider recruiting a member interested in developing Familyoriented Activities.

- Event Capacity
 - Drive events are often full in minutes, I can never get in to register
 - ... I am finding that day tours are less appealing when large numbers of cars are involved. This is particularly true when dozens and dozens of cars arrive at the destination, ie., restaurant, brewery etc. at the same time. Increase the number of Autocrosses per year from 2 to 3, maybe 4?

Social

• Event Timing

- Not every member is retired. Several of the events aren't available to someone who works Monday through Saturday.
- I would love to attend the Ladies Lunch but I have a demanding job during normal business hours. Perhaps a Ladies Weekend brunch sometimes. Also nights and weekend events in general are best for scheduling

New Events

- In my previous region (Florida Crown), we had a lot of dinners out to nice restaurants (once a month or so) and really enjoyed those.
- How do y'all decide what restaurants to go to for events like Lunch Bunch and such? Do they need to meet certain criteria?

Communications

- Share how to contribute to Horizons
- More articles about how we ended up with the Porsche that we own. I'm sure we have better stories than most of us can imagine.
- I've been a member for about a year, and just having an easier way to communicate and ask questions of members would be so helpful. IDK if Facebook, Forums, Discord or what is best, but I'd like to be able to ask the group for recommendations, suggest a quick meetup, or other ways to connect outside of formal activities. Right now I don't know how that is done or if it's possible.

Informative Responses:

General

- Schedule
 - I work an odd schedule so many events are in conflict with that. A calendar would be helpful.
 - What's wrong with holding 2 dissimilar club events on the same weekend?
- Location
 - I live in FBG so am limited on activities
 - Many events seem either way North or way south. not enough central Austin events.
 - More events in South Austin and the Hill Country, please.
 - I'm in San Marcos so southern events are always appreciated.
 - Find other members in the Waco/Temple area.
 - Please host events closer to Waco TX. Members here find it hard to get to the events that are always held in Austin.
- Local Services
 - I'd like to see a list of independent Porsche repair shops and their specialities. As a newbie to Austin I don't really know where to take my racecar etc.
 - I'm looking for more information about local services such as car washes, wheels, non-dealer service, engine modifications, body modifications, etc.
 - I would like some advice on mechanics
 - Club discounts from vendors.
- Younger Members
 - Singles Activities
 - Keep promoting new ideas to introduce a younger generation to PCA.
 - Need more events with a younger crowd.
 - I ... love what this club is doing. While I enjoy activities focusing on driving (HPDE, Autocross, Rallye, Tours, etc.) and DIY maintenance/repair (Tech sessions), the club has vibrant participation and activities that will appeal to almost anyone. The efforts of club volunteers is honorable and the results are impressive. That said, there is a belief among my fellow younger car enthusiast (and fellow young Porsche owners) that PCA is for old people. If there is something that can be done to mitigate or change this perception, I feel like it would be beneficial for the long-term health of the club. I'm also curious if this is something that varies by region or if it's consistent throughout PCA nationally. Thanks for the work you all are doing to make this the great club it is.



Informative Responses:

General

- Quality over quantity. Continue to provide sufficient access to events, while reducing the number of events, and enhancing quality.

- The Potomac team did personally contact the new members to welcome them. There would be a gathering and introduced them to fellow members to help get them involved. (HCR has a new member social)
- A listing of volunteer spots needed would be helpful I'd like to volunteer but don't know where to start.
- Yes, it would be helpful if you explain or at least say what things are. You call an event by name assuming that people know what it is. I was a member for 2 yrs. before I found out what a Schnellfest was. This named thing on the calendar, is it a lunch? A tour? Overnight or 1 day? Maybe just me, I'm slow, (tho not in my Porsche) but a short description would be useful for people who have not been evolved with HCR for very long.
